Jean-Marc Léveillé Confirms his Candidates for Greenfield Park

Longueuil, June 17, 2021 — The mayoral candidate for Longueuil Citoyen, Jean-Marc Léveillé, is pleased to confirm the candidacies of Councillors Robert Myles, Peter Doonan and Wade Wilson for the Borough of Greenfield Park.

Robert Myles, Greenfield Park District

A resident of Greenfield Park for 56 years, he was first elected in 1998. Robert Myles has been President of the Borough of Greenfield Park since 2013. He was also Leader of the Opposition from 2013 to 2017 and Leader of Option Longueuil until the merger with Longueuil Citoyen in December 2020. Among his responsibilities, Robert Myles chairs the Planning Advisory Committee of Greenfield Park, is a member of the board of directors of the *Réseau de transport de Longueuil (RTL)*, is also a member of the *Commission de la sécurité publique de l'Agglomération* and of the City's Finance Commission. Always very involved in the community, he is a member of the Lions Club as well as Vice President of the Greenfield Park Christmas Basket Association. Professionally, he worked in the aviation industry for a long time until his retirement.

Peter Doonan, Borough Councillor No.1

A resident of Greenfield Park, Peter Doonan has been a Borough Councillor since 2017. Among his responsibilities as an elected official, he acts as a resource person on the Planning Advisory Committee of Greenfield Park, in addition to sitting on the City's Social Development Commission. Professionally, he works as a Sales Manager for a company that specializes in providing innovative identification solutions that are an integral part of the business of manufacturing, distribution and retailing. A volunteer since many years, he has been involved in the Mike Reid Softball Tournament, the Greenfield Park Oldtimers hockey team, the Packers football team, not to mention his various implications in minor league hockey, soccer and baseball in Greenfield Park. He

also donates his time during the holiday season to the Christmas Basket Association. He is also an official referee of Hockey Québec.

Wade Wilson, Borough Councillor No. 2

Resident of Greenfield Park, Wade Wilson has been a Borough Councillor since 2013. Among his responsibilities as elected official, he is Vice Chairman of the Greenfield Park Planning Advisory Committee, in addition to sitting on two commissions of the City: *Commission du transport actif et de la circulation*, as well as on the *Commission loisirs, sports, culture, patrimoine et vie communautaire*. Very involved in his community, he is notably Chairman of the Board of the Mike Reid Tournament, an annual softball tournament held in Greenfield Park since 1984 in memory of Mike Reid whose goal is to raise funds for various community organizations in Greenfield Park and for the Mackay Centre School in Montreal, which offers education to hearing-impaired and disabled children. He is also Vice President of the Greenfield Park Christmas Baskets Association, an organization he has been involved with for 41 years.
